Abounding Grace: Belonging Powerful Spirit

John 14:15-26

For Discussion and Reflection

- 1. How did today's study change your view of the Holy Spirit? What did you think about my challenge to the word "helper" as translated in John?
- 2. A Paraclete represents the presence of another. Who does the Spirit represent in your life? What about that person does the Spirit communicate to you?
- 3. The incarnate Son of God, Jesus, is presented as depending on the Spirit of God for his works, his trials, and his obedience: Matthew 4:1, Luke 4:1, 4:14, 18, 10:21, John 3:34, Acts 10:38. If the same Spirit dwells within us, why are we not experiencing the same level of power?
- 4. While in prison, Paul writes the church in Philippi. How does he relate the presence of the Spirit to his current situation? Phil. 1:19. How does this communicate the comforting presence the Spirit provides?
- 5. The Spirit helps us have and understand the word of God. Consider a couple of passages: Ephesians 1:16-23, 1 Corinthians 2:11-16, John 14:26. As we are dependent on the Spirit of Truth to understand the scriptures and know God, how should we pray as we approach the Word?
- 6. Paul says that the Spirit prays for us according to the "will of God." Take a few minutes to analyze this passage and consider how the Spirit knows the will of God, and how he uses everything for our good: Romans 8:26-30. What do you learn about the Spirit from this passage?
- 7. Paul urges believers to walk with, or keep in step with, the Holy Spirit. How do we do this?
- 8. What did you learn today? How can you move into the grace that God has for you?
