

August 13, 2023 *Romans: Rooted in Jesus Gospel Roots* Romans 1:16-17

For Discussion and Reflection

- Read through these passages and summarize the symptoms: 2:1-4, 19-24, 28-29; 3:20, 27; 6:22-23; 7:4-6; 8:1-2, 12-13, 17, 31-39; 9:16, 30-32; 10:1-4,12; 12:3-4, 9-21; 13:8-10; 14-15:7(key text). As you read these passages (or a few of them) remember that Paul is speaking to people who are judging each other according to the Mosaic covenant (Law) or according to the promise of faith in Abraham.
- Paul opens and closes with this phrase, "the obedience that comes from faith," 1:5, 16:26. What do you think Paul means by that phrase? What was the Jewish focus on obedience? What did they misunderstand? Romans 3:19-20.
- 3. How does Paul express his desire for the Romans, 1:11, 16:25? What does his desire communicate?
- 4. Re-read Romans 1:16-17. Meditate on this text and discuss its meaning.
- 5. How does Romans 15:7 summarize Paul's argument (14-15:7) and apply the cure to the disease?
- 6. Where do you see similarities in the modern church? How would Paul address her needs?
- 7. Read Romans 1:1-7 in preparation for next week. Consider how Paul roots the work of Jesus in the Old Testament. How does Paul build Jesus' identity?
